WRH Course Map

The course is 3000m upstream on the River Ouse at York. This will run from Fulford Landing (after the bend) to King's Staithe, as shown below:



Start

Crews will be boating from three points: University of York Boat Club (UYBC), York City Rowing Club (YCRC), and York St. John's (YSJ).

Crews must pass under the A64 bridge before turning around to wait in draw order. Start Marshall will give instructions on where to line up along the bank.

Crews will be expected to race past Blue Bridge, and through Skeldergate Bridge. Crews will not be passing under Blue Bridge and over the River Foss under any circumstances. All crews will stay on the main channel.

Finish

The finish line will be marked by a sign on the bowside. When the finish line is crossed, crews will keep rowing through the **central arch** and listen to instructions from marshals.

- Crews boating from York St John continue to the relevant boathouses.
- Crews returning to UYBC Boat House will pass under Ouse Bridge and tuck in. They
 will move down to allow space for other crews to do the same. Marshals will provide
 crews with instructions to ensure safety and minimised traffic. Crews will not spin
 until they are told to.
- Crews returning to YCRC must stay on the correct side of the river until the end under Lendal Bridge. Crews will stop once just through Lendal Bridge, then cross over and proceed slowly to the landing stage. Marshals will be vigilant of crews that are not part of the race, and that are heading down the river.

Race marshalling will continue at Ouse Bridge and Lendal Bridge to ensure that boats finish safely.

Race Control

Crews will row through the **right hand side** of Scarbrough Bridge when rowing upstream.
